084:00 Matters Arising:

084:10 Music Group: AB reported that the book order has been approved. The hymn book costs approx $\pounds 10$. 085:10 Report from The Pastoral Area - 10 Year Plan

Fr. Tom reported on the meetings of the different small groups who have with the task of putting together the feedback required by the Diocese to help activate the intended Pastoral Area. The two main committees whose activities were reported were the Finance, and Pastoral committees. He further reported that St. Boniface Parish was commended as the only parish that prepares and keeps a budget. He reported that ultimately, there will be uniformity of events and programs for parishes in the same pastoral area. It was suggested that from time to time updates should be provided to the parishioners at large on the progress of the merger activities. This in the opinion of the Councill will create more awareness among parishioners and prepare them for eventual merger. Fr. Tom, promised to take the message back to Fr.
